Camp Director

Eric Bozeman enters his fourth season as coach of the Southern Arkansas University Muleriders. SAU has posted 11 wins each of the past two years, the highest season win total since the 2001-02 season. Prior to arriving at Southern Arkansas, Bozeman served as an assistant coach at the University of Mississippi. During his seven-year tenure at Ole Miss, the Rebels made three NCAA tournament appearances and one Sweet 16 appearance. From 1993-98 Bozeman led the Henderson State program. In his last two years with the Reddies he led the team to back-to-back 20-win seasons. Bozeman had an overall record of 71-67 at HSU. A native of Little Rock, Bozeman served as athletics director and head coach at Shorter Junior College. He played college basketball at Arkansas Tech University and was a unanimous All-Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference selection in 1981.

Coaching Staff

Some of the top high school and college coaches in this region, as well as several of the Mulerider players, will assist the SAU coaching staff in providing quality individual and team instruction.

Athletic Training Staff

The SAU athletic training staff will be on site at all times and available for the care and prevention of injuries.

Instruction

Instruction, activities, and supervision will be classified according to age. Campers will receive individual instruction in fundamental phases of basketball, including: defense, rebounding, shooting, ball handling, and passing.

Features

- * Individual and group instruction under simulated game conditions.
- * Individual and team competitions, including free-throw, ball-handling, hot shot, and three-point contests.
- * Activities such as swimming, tennis, and sand volleyball are available.
- * Awards ceremony at the close of camp.

Housing

All resident campers will live in one of SAU's air-conditioned residence halls. Two campers will be assigned to each room with room assignments made upon arrival. Twenty-four hour supervision will be provided by the camp staff.
