1	▲	1	Mount Olive College Trojans Mount Olive (49-5) has earned the No. 1 seed and will play host to the South Atlantic Regional after winning the Conference Carolinas Tournament for the third year in a row.
2	▲	2	Delta State Statesmen The Statesmen (45-9), winners of 27 of their last 28 games, will host the NCAA South Central Region Tournament
3	▲	3	Tampa Spartans The University of Tampa (38-9-1) baseball team won its third straight Sunshine State Conference championship and will host the South Regional.
4	▲	13	Sonoma State Seawolves The Seawolves (46-13) have won back-to-back CCAA titles after an improbable run through the loser's bracket and will host the West Regional.
5	▼	4	Southern Arkansas Muleriders Southern Arkansas (44-9) will travel to Cleveland, Mississippi as the #2 seed in the South Central Regional.
6	▲	7	Tusculum College Pioneers The Pioneers (40-13) won the South Atlantic Conference Tournament and will be the will be the #2 in the South Region.
7	▼	5	Emporia State Hornets ESU (48-8) fell 4-3 to Central Missouri in the championship game in the MIAA post-season tourney, but will host the Central Regional as the #1 seed.
8	▲	14	California State - Chico Wildcats The Wildcats (39-15) were beaten twice to lose the CCAA title by SSU, but do get to host the West Regional as the #3 seed.
9	▲	15	Nebraska at Omaha Mavericks The Mavericks (42-11) won the final North Central Conference championship in dominant fashion and earned the #2 seed in the Central Regional.
10	▼	6	California - San Diego Tritons UC San Diego (41-16) lost their last four games, but was awarded the #Seed in the West Regional.
11	▼	10	Columbus State Cougars The Cougars (41-17) are the #2 Seed in South Atlantic Regional to be Played at Mt. Olive College.
11	▲	12	Central Missouri Mules The Mules (41-15) won their 13th MIAA Post-Season Tournament title in the last 15 years after defeating Emporia State in the championship.
12	▼	8	West Alabama Tigers The Tigers (45-11) earned the third seed in the South Central Regional after finishing second in the Gulf South East Division
14	▲	20	Franklin Pierce University Ravens The Ravens (39-12) are the top seed and host of the Northeast Regional after claiming their second-straight NE-10 Tournament title on Sunday.
15	▼	9	Abilene Christian Wildcats The Wildcats (43-15) will be the #4 seed in the tournament after finishing second in the Lone Star Conference tournament.
16	▲	NR	Grand Valley State Lakers Grand Valley State (34-11) won the GLIAC Championship and has now won six straight GLIAC Titles and 13 overall.
17	▲	17	Wayne State College - Nebraska Wildcats Wayne State (40-11) was the runner up in the Northern Sun Conference Tournament, and were awarded with the #3 seed in the Central Regional.
18	▲	22	Catawba College Indians Catawba (40-16) received an at-large bid after a nice showing in the SAC Tournament and late wins over Erskine.

19	▲	21	Western Oregon Wolves The Wolves (39-17) are the #5 seed in the West Regional after winning the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. The Wolves have now won seven consecutive GNAC championships in a row.
20	▲	27	West Virginia State Yellow Jackets W.Va. State (36-12) received the #2 seed in the North Atlantic Regional after winning the West Virginia Intercollegiate Conference title.
21	▼	19	South Carolina Aiken Pacers USC Aiken (44-15) was ousted by Francis Marion in the semi finals of the PBC Tournament. The Pacers are the #3 seed in the South Atlantic Regional.
22	▼	18	Ouachita Baptist Tigers Ouachita Baptist (43-14), makes just its second Tournament in school history as the fifth seed in the South Central Regional.
23	▼	11	Erskine College Flying Fleet Erskine (44-8) is the #6 seed in the South Atlantic Regional and need to get back on track after losing their last three games.
24	▲	26	West Chester Pennsylvania Golden Rams West Chester (41-14) lost the PSAC to Kutztown, but were awarded the #1 seed in the North Atlantic Regional
25	▲	NR	Northern Kentucky Norse Northern Kentucky (36-22) woke up early on Monday to battle Pumas for the GLVC crown and hammered SJC to advance to the NCAAs.
26	▲	NR	Southern Connecticut State Fighting Owls The Owls (36-17) are the #3 seed in the Northeast Regional after an awesome end of the year where they beat everyone except #1 seed Franklin Pierce.
27	▲	NR	California State - Stanislaus Warriors Cal State Stanislaus (37-21) will enter West Region tournament as the #4 after being eliminated from the CCAA Championship against SSU.
28	●	28	Belmont Abbey College Crusaders The Crusaders (40-20) had the most wins in school history, and were awarded with the #5 seed in the South Atlantic Regional.
29	▼	24	Saint Josephs College - Indiana Pumas SJU (44-15) finished second to the Norse of NKU in the GLVC Championship on Monday morning.
