The Series (9-3, Valdosta State)

Monday's game between Southern Arkansas and No. 14 Valdosta State is the 13th consecutive meeting of the two teams since their first game in 1996 in Valdosta, Ga. The Blazers shut out the Muleriders 42-0 that day behind All-America quarterback Lance Funderburk. The next season, SAU defeated VSU 17-7 en route to a Gulf South Conference championship. In '98, Southern Arkansas won by a 40-13 margin, and made it three in a row in '99 with a 28-14 decision in Valdosta, concluding the Muleriders' only wins in the series and obviously, their longest streak.

Valdosta State has won the last eight games in the series, starting in 2000 as a 5-5 SAU team was nipped at the final buzzer, 30-29. The Blazers breezed to a 41-14 win over Southern Arkansas in '01, eked out a 31-28 decision in '02, came from behind in the last four minutes to claim a 41-17 win in '03, outscored the Muleriders 45-28 in 2004 en route to the NCAA Division II national championship, claimed a hard-earned, come-from-behind, 44-41 cliffhanger in '05, and won 41-7 in Valdosta two years ago. VSU continued its winning streak against SAU last year as the fifth-ranked team in the nation, pulling out a 33-21 victory in Magnolia on their way again to the national championship.

Holding a 9-3 advantage in the series, Valdosta State has a 4-2 edge in games played in Magnolia and a 5-1 margin in Valdosta.

The Coaches

This will be the 85th game for **Steve Quinn** (Ouachita Baptist, 1985) as head coach of the Muleriders. He finished his first season at SAU in 2001 with a 5-5 record, was 7-4 in 2002, and improved to 9-3 his third season, guiding SAU to an NCAA Division II national playoff berth. In 2004, the Muleriders slumped to 5-6, the first losing season at SAU since 1996, before improving to 6-5 in 2005. The Muleriders had a combined 5-16 mark over the next two years during a rebuilding period. Quinn is now 38-46 at SAU following last week's 21-3 home loss to No. 5 Delta State. A native of Mena, Quinn played at Ouachita Baptist for legendary Coach Buddy Benson along with former SAU and current Arkansas State University Coach Steve Roberts and current OBU Coach Todd Knight. Quinn, who had previously been the assistant head coach for Roberts at SAU, returned as the head coach of the Muleriders after a year at Northwestern State (La.) University, where he was on the staff of Roberts, serving as assistant head coach. Quinn had previously coached at Pascagoula High School, Ouachita Baptist, Baylor University, Northwestern Missouri State, and Eastern New Mexico State as an assistant.

David Dean (Georgia State, 1986) is 20-3 overall in his second season as head of the Valdosta State program. Quite productive in his inaugural season, he led last year's squad to a 13-1 mark and the Division II National Championship. Dean had previously been the offensive coordinator at Valdosta State since 2000. Prior to joining the Blazer staff, Dean served from 1992-99 as an assistant coach at West Georgia, the last two of which was spent as the Wolves' offensive coordinator. He began his collegiate career at VSU in 1988 with a four-year stint as wide receivers coach. Dean also was wide receivers coach at Avondale (Ga.) High School during the 1987 season and spent the 1986 school year as a graduate assistant coach at Georgia Tech. He was a walk-on at Georgia Tech in 1982 and earned a scholarship the following year as he played wide receiver for the Yellow Jackets through 1985.

Monday's Game

Monday's contest between Southern Arkansas and Valdosta State is believed to be the first time that Southern Arkansas has played on this day of the week, and is quite possibly the first time a Gulf South Conference game will have taken place on a Monday. The Muleriders and Blazers were supposed to have met September 13, but the contest was postponed because of Hurricane Ike.

SAU hopes to bring an end to an eight-game losing streak to VSU Monday, as they have not won in the series since 1999. Southern Arkansas was within 27-21 late in the fourth quarter last year in Magnolia until a Valdosta State interception return for a touchdown put the game out of reach with two minutes remaining.

SAU is now 421-390-30 in 91 years of football since their first season of play in 1911. They did not field teams from 1937-1939 and 1942-1945. Southern Arkansas is currently 56-59 in Gulf South Conference games since joining the league in their move to Division II in 1995. All-time, they are 195-213-8 against teams currently in the GSC.

HEAD COACH



Coach Steve Quinn begins his eighth season leading the Mulerider football team.

Quinn spent 2000 as an assistant at Northwestern State (La.) University before returning to Southern Arkansas in 2001 as head coach. He had been with SAU from 1997-1999 as assistant head coach and offensive line coach when the Muleriders posted records of 9-2, 8-2, and 9-1, for a combined 26-5 record over the three-year period and the school's first Gulf South Conference championship in 1997. In the process, SAU shattered several school records and dominated GSC offensive statistics. SAU was ranked 11th nationally in 1997 and 15th in 1998 and 1999. In '98, the Muleriders ranked ninth nationally in scoring offense, 18th in rushing offense, led the GSC in scoring and rushing offense, and broke six school offensive records. In '99, SAU led the conference in total offense and rushing offense, ranking 14th nationally in rushing offense. Over the three-year period, Quinn produced eight All-GSC offensive linemen and one All-American.

In Quinn's second season as head coach in 2002, he again had SAU ranked in the national statistics as the team finished 12th in rushing offense, 14th in scoring offense, and 22nd in total offense. His 2003 Muleriders made the NCAA Division II national playoffs and finished the year ranked 11th nationally. That team ranked 18th nationally in rushing offense, 33rd in scoring offense, led the nation in punt returns, and finished 13th in kickoff returns.

Through the years, Quinn's teams have ranked highly in national statistics. His 2005 squad finished

sixth in rushing offense and 22nd in both total offense and rushing defense. They were 31st in rushing offense in 2006 and 30th this past season.

Before his first stint at SAU, Quinn was at Eastern New Mexico from 1994-96, where he served as offensive coordinator while working with the offensive line. In 1993 and 1994 he was at Northwest Missouri State University as an assistant; at Pascagoula (Miss.) High School from 1989-92 as offensive coordinator; Baylor University in 1987 and 1988 as a graduate assistant; and at his alma mater, Ouachita Baptist University, in 1986, as a part-time assistant coach where he worked with defensive ends and linebackers.

Quinn graduated from OBU in 1985 with his B.S.E., and received his M.Ed. from Baylor in 1989. He graduated from Mena High School in 1981.

Quinn, and wife, Jodi, are parents of four children, daughters Hannah and Hillary, and sons Nicholas and Troy.

Team Leaders

SAU LEADERS: Southern Arkansas managed just 106 yards of total offense, including only two rushing, in falling 21-3 to Delta State in their October 25 game.

Fullback Mark Johnson finished with 24 yards rushing on 11 carries, but the Muleriders suffered 60 yards in loss after gaining 62 as a team. Quarterbacks Quintin Porter and Ryan McCombie combined to complete 11 of 31 passes for 104 yards, with McCombie throwing two interceptions. Porter was 6 of 13 for 66 yards, but was sacked three times. Receiver Isaac Marrufo caught five passes for 72 yards.

Linebacker Simeon Oston led SAU's defense with eight tackles, including five solo. Defensive back Brandon Wilson and linebacker Steven Dauenhauer had seven stops each, Wilson getting six solos and Dauenhauer five. Dauenhauer had 1.5 tackles for loss, including a sack, and had one quarterback hurry. Punter Zach Massingill was called on quite a bit and responded by averaging 44.8 yards on eight boots, with a long of 51 and dropping one inside the 20.

For the year, Johnson has rushed for 524 yards on 110 attempts, with five touchdowns. Porter has 370 yards on 98 carries and four TD's. McCombie is 78 of 188 passing for 930 yards and four touchdowns, but has 10 picks, while Porter is 23 of 51 for 278 yards with five interceptions. Marrufo has 31 receptions for 398 yards and a TD, while Raphyael Tyson has 19 for 243 yards and a score. Clarence Wright has 22 kickoff returns for a 20.0 average and also has 12 punt returns for an 11.4 average.

Defensively, Wright leads the team with 56 tackles, 40 solo, with 2.5 for loss, including a sack. He has one interception, has broken up six passes and forced a fumble. Dauenhauer and defensive back Daren Lewis have 41 tackles apiece, both with 31 solos. Dauenhauer has 2.5 for loss with a sack, two forced fumbles, and a blocked kick, while Lewis has three breakups and has also blocked a kick.

VSU LEADERS: Valdosta State piled up 446 yards of offense, including 265 on the ground, in claiming their 41-14 win over West Georgia Thursday in the GSC TV Game of the Week.

Freshman running back Michael Brown, not even listed on the depth chart, rushed for 129 yards and a touchdown on 13 carries. Quarterback Tucker Pruitt was 14 of 18 passing for 155 yards and one TD. Receiver Cedric Jones caught four of those passes for 51 yards, as the Blazers utilized 11 different receivers. VSU also helped themselves in field position with three different punt returns totaling 111 yards.

Strong safety Everett Kitchens and linebackers Cody Vining and Demarcus Flanagan accumulated seven tackles apiece in the game, with Flanagan assisting on a tackle for loss. Jack Fulford averaged 43 yards on three punts, with two dropped inside the 20.

On the season, running back Markus Manson has rushed for 420 yards and four scores on 73 carries. Quarterback Chris Hart, Brown and running back Ronnye Nelson also see plenty of touches, with Hart accumulating 276 yards, Brown 274, and Nelson 263. Valdosta has primarily used two quarterbacks with Hart seeing the most action. He's 114 of 202 for 1,441 yards and 14 touchdowns, with only four picks. Pruitt is 67 of 107 for 737 yards and eight TD's with four interceptions. Jones has 43 catches for 429 yards and one score, while receiver Albert Dukes has 32 for 340 yards and six touchdowns. VSU has six players with at least over 100 yards receiving. T.J. Williams has returned nine kicks for a 15.1 average, while Roger King has 14 punt returns for an 11.1 average.

Linebacker Larry Dean leads the club defensively, recording 71 tackles, 30 solo, with seven for loss, including three sacks. Dean also has one interception, three pass breakups, and two forced fumbles. Linebacker Brian Buford and cornerback Carlos Anderson have 52 tackles apiece, with Buford posting 7.5 for loss with 1.5 sacks, and adding an interception, while Anderson has six stops for loss, including 3.5 sacks, and has three pass breakups. Fulford is averaging 42.1 yards on 42 punts.

Last Meeting

Three turnovers in the final 7:35 proved costly to Southern Arkansas as fifth-ranked Valdosta State held on for a 33-21 win last year in Magnolia.

The Muleriders were haunted by seven turnovers overall, but none hurt them more when trailing just 27-21 in the closing minutes, than the final three. Trailing 27-7 at the end of the third quarter, SAU put up two quick scores at the beginning of the fourth to pull within striking distance. After forcing a Blazers' punt, Southern Arkansas took over at their own 24, got 13 yards rushing on two attempts, but then quarterback Josh SanFilippo threw his third interception of the day as Roger King picked him off at the Mulerider 49. VSU gave it right back three plays later on a fumble as defensive back Rodney Anthony stripped the ball and recovered to the SAU 47. Southern Arkansas promptly moved to the Valdosta State 17, where SanFilippo's bad toss allowed the Blazers to recover at the 22. After moving to the 40, the Mulerider defense held on fourth and one, taking over on downs with 2:13 remaining. On first down, SanFilippo's pass was picked off by Jamaal Clark, who returned it 45 yards for the touchdown to essentially seal the game. The Blazers went for two, but were denied, leaving it 33-21.

VSU took the opening kickoff, moving 71 yards in 13 plays to jump out to a 7-0 lead when quarterback Willie Copeland hit receiver Cedric Jones for a four yard score and Zac Williams converted at 9:13 in the first. SAU returned the favor on their ensuing possession as running back Steven Ashley took the handoff and bolted 59 yards for the touchdown. Noe' Cuevas' kick was good and it was knotted at 8:56. Valdosta added three more in the first on Williams' 38-yard field goal at 6:27.

Williams had a chance to spot the Blazers with three more at the beginning of the second quarter, but his 36-yarder was wide left. Southern Arkansas backup quarterback Quintin Porter then had the team's second turnover when he immediately lost a fumble. VSU took advantage and this time Williams' 34-yard attempt was good, making it 13-7 at 10:54, which stood at the half.

It was all Valdosta State in the third as the Muleriders lost an opportunity early when Cuevas missed his first field goal of the season, this one from 31. The Blazers capitalized, moving 80 yards in only four plays, concluding with Copeland's five-yard toss to Cedric Evans for the score at 9:20. Copeland hit Zach Parker for 63 yards on the prior play. After forcing a VSU fumble, SAU took over with great position at the visitor's 26, but on the second play, SanFilippo's second interception went to the hands of Shawn Harris, who rumbled it back 86 yards for a 27-7 Valdosta lead at 5:55.

Southern Arkansas' scoring in the fourth came on Chris Metcalf's one-yard dive at 14:16, which concluded a 15-play 77-yard drive, and SanFilippo's 32-yard pass to Mario Coleman with 9:23 remaining.

The Muleriders out-gained the Blazers 363 to 311 total yards, but couldn't overcome the turnovers. SAU actually coughed the ball up four other times, but recovered them. The game saw a combined 10 turnovers, with VSU dropping four on the ground and losing three. Southern Arkansas held Valdosta State to just 28 rushing yards on 20 carries, but the Blazers put up 283 through the air. The Muleriders finished with 171 rushing and 192 passing.

* Southern Arkansas will honor their 14 seniors prior to Monday's game, who will be playing in the final home game of their careers: Fullback Jayvian Johnson and offensive tackle Roderick Taylor from the offensive side, and from the defense, linebackers Steven Dauenhauer, Brandon Millbrooks and Cordell Upshaw; ends Khedrick Dixon, Chandler Richardson and Chase Richardson; nose guard DeRalph Guy; tackle LaDaryl Kirkwood; cornerbacks Roland Perkins and Brandon Wilson; and safeties Clarence Wright and Ricky Wright.

* The Muleriders' running game will be tested for the second consecutive game as the Blazer defense comes in 20th in the nation in allowing just 97.5 yards a contest. Delta State came in last week against SAU at 21st allowing 95.3 yards and held Southern Arkansas to a total of two yards, jumping them to 13th at 83.6. The Muleriders, who were 18th with 211 yards rushing a game, fell to 33rd at 184.9. SAU's defense is no slouch in stopping the run either, ranked 30th in holding opponents to 105.5 yards a game.

Valdosta punter Jack Fulford is ninth in Division II, averaging 42.0 yards a boot, while Southern Arkansas' Zach Massingill is 28th at 39.9.

* The Muleriders close out their season on the road November 8 at Arkansas-Monticello. A rejuvenated team, the Boll Weevils currently sit at 7-2 on the season and jumped into the national rankings this week for the first time since 2000, at No. 23, all prior to this Saturday's game at No. 6 North Alabama.
