### The Series (49-33-1, Southern Arkansas)

Saturday's game will be the 84th meeting between Southern Arkansas and Arkansas-Monticello in a series that began in 1913 and serves as the longest-standing rival for the Muleriders. The Boll Weevils concluded their sixth win of the first nine games in the series with their largest margin ever, a 46-0 shutout in Monticello in 1924. SAU returned the favor the next season with their largest margin of victory, a 91-0 blowout in Magnolia that started a streak of three wins to even it at six wins apiece. The series has only one tie, a scoreless stalemate played in El Dorado in 1933.

Southern Arkansas' longest string of wins was an 11-game stretch from 1967-1977, with a 43-0 blanking in their final game of the 1972 season included that gave the Muleriders a share of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference championship. UAM owns a pair of five-win streaks, from 1962-1966 and 1992-1996. Following the '96 game, SAU won the next seven until Arkansas-Monticello pulled out a 33-31 victory in Magnolia in 2004. The 1999 game was initially a 23-20 Boll Weevil win, but UAM had to forfeit it because of the use of an ineligible player. The 2004 game remains Arkansas-Monticello's last win in the series as Southern Arkansas won 52-21 in 2005 in Monticello; 18-15 in 2006 in a game that had to be played at Magnolia High School's Panther Stadium; and 38-21 last year in Monticello, giving the Muleriders 10 wins in the past 11 games.

SAU leads the series by a 49-33-1 margin, holding a 25-17 advantage in games played in Monticello, 22-16 in Magnolia, and 2-0-1 in three games in El Dorado.

### The Coaches

This will be the 86th game for **Steve Quinn** (Ouachita Baptist, 1985) as head coach of the Muleriders. He finished his first season at SAU in 2001 with a 5-5 record, was 7-4 in 2002, and improved to 9-3 his third season, guiding SAU to an NCAA Division II national playoff berth. In 2004, the Muleriders slumped to 5-6, the first losing season at SAU since 1996, before improving to 6-5 in 2005. The Muleriders had a combined 5-16 mark over the next two years during a rebuilding period. Quinn is now 38-47 at SAU following last week's 38-16 home loss to No. 14 Valdosta State. A native of Mena, Quinn played at Ouachita Baptist for legendary Coach Buddy Benson along with former SAU and current Arkansas State University Coach Steve Roberts and current OBU Coach Todd Knight. Quinn, who had previously been the assistant head coach for Roberts at SAU, returned as the head coach of the Muleriders after a year at Northwestern State (La.) University, where he was on the staff of Roberts, serving as assistant head coach. Quinn had previously coached at Pascagoula High School, Ouachita Baptist, Baylor University, Northwestern Missouri State, and Eastern New Mexico State as an assistant.

UAM's **Gwayne Mathews** (Delta State, 1988) is in his fourth year as head coach of the Boll Weevils. Following a pair of 1-10 seasons, Mathews improved Arkansas-Monticello to 4-7 last year and has the team to a 7-3 level this season, giving him an overall mark of 13-30. Before arriving at Arkansas-Monticello, Mathews was the defensive coordinator at Tennessee-Chattanooga for the previous two years. He served in the same capacity at North Alabama in 2001-2002, and also at his alma mater, Delta State, from 1998-2000. A native of New Orleans, La., Mathews began his coaching career at De La Salle High School in New Orleans. After his college ball at Delta State, Mathews went to the Canadian Football League where he played parts of two seasons for the Winnipeg Blue Bombers.

### Saturday's Game

Southern Arkansas carries a three-game winning streak over Arkansas-Monticello into Saturday's game, and has won 10 of the past 11 meetings. The Boll Weevils' lone win in that span was a 33-31 decision in 2004. Games played in Monticello have been good to the Muleriders, as they hold a 25-17 advantage there, a higher win percentage than when playing in Magnolia.

SAU is now 421-391-30 in 91 years of football since their first season of play in 1911. They did not field teams from 1937-1939 and 1942-1945. Southern Arkansas is currently 56-60 in Gulf South Conference games since joining the league in their move to Division II in 1995. All-time, they are 195-214-8 against teams currently in the GSC.

# HEAD COACH



Coach Steve Quinn begins his eighth season leading the Mulerider football team.

Quinn spent 2000 as an assistant at Northwestern State (La.) University before returning to Southern Arkansas in 2001 as head coach. He had been with SAU from 1997-1999 as assistant head coach and offensive line coach when the Muleriders posted records of 9-2, 8-2, and 9-1, for a combined 26-5 record over the three-year period and the school's first Gulf South Conference championship in 1997. In the process, SAU shattered several school records and dominated GSC offensive statistics. SAU was ranked 11th nationally in 1997 and 15th in 1998 and 1999. In '98, the Muleriders ranked ninth nationally in scoring offense, 18th in rushing offense, led the GSC in scoring and rushing offense, and broke six school offensive records. In '99, SAU led the conference in total offense and rushing offense, ranking 14th nationally in rushing offense. Over the three-year period, Quinn produced eight All-GSC offensive linemen and one All-American.

In Quinn's second season as head coach in 2002, he again had SAU ranked in the national statistics as the team finished 12th in rushing offense, 14th in scoring offense, and 22nd in total offense. His 2003 Muleriders made the NCAA Division II national playoffs and finished the year ranked 11th nationally. That team ranked 18th nationally in rushing offense, 33rd in scoring offense, led the nation in punt returns, and finished 13th in kickoff returns.

Through the years, Quinn's teams have ranked highly in national statistics. His 2005 squad finished

sixth in rushing offense and 22nd in both total offense and rushing defense. They were 31st in rushing offense in 2006 and 30th this past season.

Before his first stint at SAU, Quinn was at Eastern New Mexico from 1994-96, where he served as offensive coordinator while working with the offensive line. In 1993 and 1994 he was at Northwest Missouri State University as an assistant; at Pascagoula (Miss.) High School from 1989-92 as offensive coordinator; Baylor University in 1987 and 1988 as a graduate assistant; and at his alma mater, Ouachita Baptist University, in 1986, as a part-time assistant coach where he worked with defensive ends and linebackers.

Quinn graduated from OBU in 1985 with his B.S.E., and received his M.Ed. from Baylor in 1989. He graduated from Mena High School in 1981.

Quinn, and wife, Jodi, are parents of four children, daughters Hannah and Hillary, and sons Nicholas and Troy.

## Team Leaders

**SAU LEADERS:** Southern Arkansas was held to below 300 yards of total offense for the second consecutive game as Valdosta State limited the Muleriders to just 288 yards total in their 38-16 win over SAU.

Southern Arkansas got 151 yards on the ground, led by fullback Mark Johnson who finished with 50 yards rushing on eight carries. Halfback Chris Metcalf had 40 on nine totes, and two touchdowns. Quarterback Ryan McCombie was 12 of 31 passing for 119 yards., with receiver Isaac Marrufo catching four of those for 35 yards.

Defensive back Clarence Wright led the team with eight tackles, six solo, with an assisted tackle for loss. Linebacker Matt Comer had six stops, with five solo.

For the year, Johnson has rushed for 574 yards on 118 attempts, with five touchdowns. Quarterback Quintin Porter has 377 yards on 103 carries and four TD's. McCombie is 90 of 219 passing for 1,049 yards and four touchdowns, but has 10 picks, while Porter is 25 of 57 for 296 yards with five interceptions. Marrufo has 35 receptions for 433 yards and a TD, while Raphyael Tyson has 20 for 247 yards and a score. Wright has 22 kickoff returns for a 20.0 average and also has 16 punt returns for a 9.6 average.

Defensively, Wright leads the team with 64 tackles, 46 solo, with three for loss, including a sack. He has one interception, has broken up six passes and forced a fumble. Linebackers Steven Dauenhauer and Simeon Oston have 45 and 44 tackles, respectively. Dauenhauer has 33 solo, with 3.5 for loss, including a sack, and has three forced fumbles and one blocked kick. Oston has 27 solos, with eight for loss, including 3.5 sacks, and has broken up a pass and recovered a fumble.

**UAM LEADERS:** Arkansas-Monticello's playoff hopes took a hit in their 45-14 setback to North Alabama last week as the Lions limited them to 326 yards of offense, including just 100 through the air.

Quarterback phenom Scott Buisson threw for only 99 yards and a touchdown on 13 of 33 attempts, but managed 165 yards rushing and added another TD on 17 carries. Receiver Tim Harris had six receptions for 45 yards with the score.

Linebacker Larry White racked up 13 tackles in the contest, with 10 solo, including 1.5 tackles for loss. Linebackers Quenton Arnett and Jeremy Brown, and defensive back Danzel Isaac had six stops apiece. Arnett broke up a pass; Isaac had 2.5 tackles for loss, including two sacks; and Brown assisted on a tackle for loss and broke up a pass.

On the season, Buisson is 187 for 318 passing for 2,455 yards and 23 touchdowns, and has nine interceptions. He has rushed for 1,238 yards and 12 touchdowns on 182 carries, averaging 6.8 yards per rush. Running back Johnny Polite has 137 rushes for 597 yards and three scores. Harris has caught 51 passes for 678 yards and eight TD's, while receiver Clarence Denmark has 46 for 876 yards and 10 touchdowns. Denmark is also averaging 20.1 yards on 27 kickoff returns, and Lindsey Spinks averages 6.6 yards on 16 punt returns.

Defensive back Emanuel White has 74 tackles on the year, 45 solo with 1.5 for loss. He has two interceptions and eight breakups. White has 73 stops, 44 solo, with 9.5 for loss, including one sack. He has forced a fumble and recovered two. Arnett has totaled 44 tackles, 34 solo with 3.5 for loss, has six interceptions, seven breakups, and has blocked a kick. Derek Jambon averages 40.7 yards on 36 punts.

## Last Meeting

Southern Arkansas scored 31 unanswered points in the final three quarters to overcome an early 14-0 deficit and hand Arkansas-Monticello a 38-21 setback last year in the teams' season-opener in Monticello.

The Boll Weevils scored twice in the first 10 minutes of the game on 45 and 49-yard touchdown passes from quarterback Scott Buisson to Tim Harris and Clarence Denmark, respectively. After the Muleriders got on the board at 4:28 on fullback Tony McDonald's five-yard scamper, UAM answered with a five-yard run from running back Johnny Polite at 3:26 and held a 21-7 advantage at the end of one quarter. That's when the SAU blood-letting began as they held Arkansas-Monticello scoreless and allowed just 187 yards of offense the rest of the way.

McDonald got the first of three second quarter touchdowns and the scoring spree started for the Muleriders on a 19-yard touchdown reception from quarterback Josh SanFilippo at 13:21. Running back Keundric Loucious knotted it up, 21-21, on a six-yard run at 11:10 and fullback Jayvian Johnson gave SAU its first lead of the game at 6:59 on a 13-yard dash.

Red-shirt freshman Noe Cuevas, who converted on all five Southern Arkansas touchdowns, gave the Muleriders a 31-21 edge with his 23-yard field goal at 8:18 in the third stanza. SAU concluded its scoring at 13:38 in the final quarter when SanFilippo hit tight end Johnny Fields for a 10-yard score.

The Boll Weevils churned out 217 total yards in building their first quarter lead and finished with 404. Southern Arkansas responded with 424 total yards, including 296 on the ground. UAM finished with 154 yards rushing and put up 250 through the air, but got almost half that, with 123, in the first quarter.

A big part of the Mulerider offense over the final three quarters came courtesy of their defense as it forced five Arkansas-Monticello turnovers during that span, three fumbles and two interceptions. SAU pulled two off the ground and one from the air in the second quarter alone.

SanFilippo piled up 238 yards of total offense, completing 10 of 17 passes for 128 yards and the two touchdowns, and rushed for 110 yards on 16 carries. Loucious had six rushes for 58 yards and his score, and Fields hauled in five receptions for 62 yards and the TD.

Southern Arkansas' kicking game, which had been somewhat inconsistent in the recent past, showed improvement, as besides Cuevas' poised performance, true freshman Zach Massingill was excellent punting the ball, averaging 40.4 yards on five punts, including a long of 62.

The Mulerider defense finished with nine tackles behind the line of scrimmage, including six sacks. Linebacker Steven Dauenhauer and rover C.J. Ellis each came up with 1.5 sacks, while four others grabbed the rest. Dauenhauer had five tackles, including three solo, had two behind the line for 10 yards in loss, and forced a fumble. Linebacker Ronnie Booker and cornerback Clarence Wright added five tackles each, both getting four solos, with Booker getting one for a loss and he also added a pass breakup.

## Of Interest

\* Two of the Gulf South Conference's top three rushing teams meet in Saturday's game as Arkansas-Monticello (257.2) leads the league and is fifth nationally, and Southern Arkansas (181.1) is third and 38th. Boll Weevil quarterback Scott Buisson leads the conference with 123.8 yards per game, while running back Johnny Polite is sixth (66.3). Mulerider fullback Mark Johnson is fourth (71.8) in rushing.

\* SAU's running game will be tested against this week as they will have faced the GSC's top three run defenses in their past three games. The UAM defense is currently 13th in the nation and second in the conference in allowing just 87.0 yards a contest. Southern Arkansas managed just two yards against Delta State two weeks ago when they were allowing 95.3 yards, and had 151 against Valdosta State Monday, which was giving up just 91.6. SAU's defense is no slouch in stopping the run either, ranked 20th nationally and fourth in the GSC in holding opponents to 95.0 yards a game.

Arkansas-Monticello is ranked high in several national categories, both offensively and defensively. They are third in total offense (513.4); fifth in rushing (257.2); 18th in scoring (36.1); and 28th in passing (256.2). They are third in D-II, picking off 22 interceptions; tied at seventh in turnovers gained (33); and 13th in rushing defense (87.0).

\* Following his GSC Freshman of the Year honor last season, Buisson has done everything for the Boll Weevils again this year. He is 17th in the nation in passing yards (2,455) and 21st in yards per game (245.5); fourth in rushing yards (1,238) and seventh in yards per game (123.8); and fourth in total offense (369.3).
